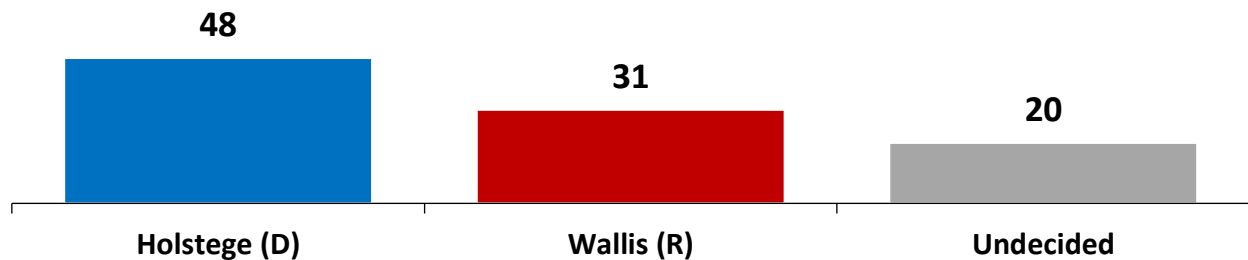

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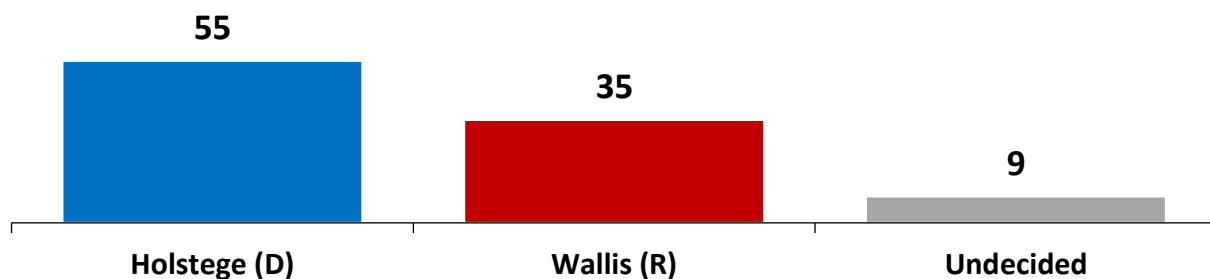
Our new poll<sup>1</sup> of likely November 2022 general election voters in Assembly District 47 shows **Democrat Christy Holstege with a strong lead of +17 points over Republican Greg Wallis, 48% to 31%** with 20% of voters undecided. Before any introduction, Holstege is winning registered Democrats by +78 points and No Party Preference voters by +23.

### Initial Ballot



After head-to-head positive introductions for both candidates, Holstege pulls ahead to 55% and Wallis moves to 35% of the vote, expanding Holstege's margin to +20 points.

### Informed Ballot



Christy Holstege's strong performance at this early stage demonstrates that she is well-positioned to win this race.

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<sup>i</sup>Lake Research Partners designed and administered this survey, which was conducted by live telephone interview. The survey reached a sample of 400 likely general election voters in California AD-47, plus an oversample of 150 registered NPP likely voters. The survey was conducted August 11-15, 2022. Data were weighted slightly by gender, age, race, region, party registration, and education level to reflect the expected demographic composition of likely general election voters in the district. The margin of error for the full sample is +/-4.9%.
