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## AD 47 Survey Findings

A recent Tulchin Research poll among 400 likely voters in California's 47<sup>th</sup> State Assembly district finds Democrat Christy Holstege currently leading Republican Greg Wallis outside of the survey's margin of error. Specifically, Holstege leads by 9 points and attracts more than half the vote (51%) compared to the 4-in-10 voters that support Wallis (42%). With just 7% undecided, Holstege is in a very strong position to win this seat with just over five weeks remaining in the race and with ballots hitting mailboxes soon.

### California's 47<sup>th</sup> State Assembly 2022 Horserace

Additionally, voters seem to be hearing a fair amount about Holstege (58% heard), and what they are hearing is making a positive impression (+23 more-less favorable). Conversely, voters are not hearing nearly as much about Wallis (48% heard), and with more mixed sentiments (+4 more-less favorable) about what they are hearing about him.

In sum, Christy Holstege leads the race for Assembly in the 47<sup>th</sup> district and voters are hearing notably more about her and have more positive sentiments about what they are hearing compared to her opponent.

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**Survey Methodology:** From September 24-29, 2022, Tulchin Research conducted a multi-modal survey among 400 voters in California's 47<sup>th</sup> State Assembly District. The margin of error for the survey is +/- 4.9%.
